3. Review of Work done so far on Emergency Plan

Leaflet & questionnaire sent to HEPS, no reply to date. Councillors who have not responded to their mobile number on the leaflet to be chased and left off if necessary. Secure key box purchased.

Add high tides on the River Humber over 7metres to the leaflet if possible, about 12 a year.

4. Flood Risk

Mark Bannister was thanked for sending his Barton Town Surface Water Flood Risk document for councillors to see before this meeting. Members discussed past surface water and river water flooding in the town and how the town drains cope with excess water. Having a town wide map showing high risk areas, stopping water getting into drains in the first place, permeable paving, underground springs in Baysgarth Park and water butts were all discussed.

Agreed to contact

- a) North Lincolnshire Council Highway/Flooding officer if they would attend a future Emergency Planning meeting to discuss feasibility of permeable paving when replacing paving in the town.
- b) Anglian Water regarding water butts beyond 2025 which was mentioned in Mark's report as something for the future to reduce storm overflow on residential properties.
- c) Anglian Water for a copy of sewage system map of Barton which cost £30 to the public for a small area. Also check if North Lincolnshire Council have a copy of this map.
- d) M Bannister will send contact details for his contact at Anglian Water.
