## PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION (PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY 330, BARTON-UPON-HUMBER) ORDER 2025(1)

On 11 June 2025, North Lincolnshire Council confirmed the above order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish the public bridleway in Barton-upon-Humber running either side of the A15 from the B1218 Brigg Road to the A15's western perimeter (TA02361885 to TA02471884) and from the A15's eastern perimeter to its junction with the length of BW330 leading north towards Kingsforth Hall (TA02531884 to TA03031886) as shown on the order map, and to modify the 'County of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg)' definitive map and statement in consequence.

The order comes into force as from 18 June 2025, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 26 June 2025, make an application to the High Court.
