224. **Environment Budget 2026-2027**

Member discussed the budget line by line.

There will only be 12 Up the Pole planters being planted up for Autumn 2025.

Chair reminded the costs are required for the new signs for the 4 entrances to the town showing that Barton Upon Humber is Best Kept Small Town 2025 and Best Kept Community Planting 2025.

It was agreed to costs for 9 cuts to the parks except for Dam Road Park which will need 12 cuts. To include an additional £800 in the budget for this cost.

Members requested costs to improve the War Memorial planting 2026. It was agreed to purchase 2 new planters from 2025-2026 budget. This would require permission and Clerks are looking into where the permission should be obtained.
