Invitation to Contract

Barton Upon Humber PROW (Public Rights of Way) Cutting

Barton Upon Humber Town Council are seeking quotations from an experienced Contractor to maintain the public rights of ways in Barton Upon Humber.

The services must include:

- General grass cutting of all the public rights of way as agreed by the Council
- Trimming back minor work to trees and shrubbery that may be preventing the public rights of way being used.
- Any bridges located on the PROW will need to be cleared of any shrubbery preventing the bridge being used
- A minimum number of 4 cuts to be carried out during the months of April to October however additional cuts may be required if agreed by the Council
- All public rights of way to be cut to a maximum of 30mm
- Additional paths may be added to the contract subject to the town councils requirements

Start Date:

The successful applicant's contract will begin on: 1st January 2027 and will expire 31st December 2030.

Hours of work

The hours will be dictated by the contractor ensuring all agreed public rights of way are cut to the specified width

Payment

An invoice will be required to be sent to the Town Council each month confirming an equal set amount which must be clearly detailed in your submitted quotation.

The contractor will need to have the relevant insurance and will be required to submit to the Clerk work risk assessments and method statements
