Invitation to Contract

Barton Upon Humber - Barton Parks

Barton Upon Humber Town Council are seeking quotations from an experienced Contractor to carry out grass cutting to Dam Road Park, Butts Road Park, Tofts Road Park and Lapwing Way Open Space

The services must include:

- General grass cutting to all parks as listed a minimum of 16 times, more may be required upon the request of the town council
- Trimming back minor work to trees and shrubbery that may be preventing the parks being used
- As an indication, grass shall in general not be longer than 100mm and no shorter than 30mm.
- The cut shall be uniform throughout the designated area.
- Due care and attention shall be given to grassed perimeter edges, including bulbs, wildlife areas and any obstacles e.g. fence posts, trees etc.
- Edges to play equipment, bins, seats etc shall be maintained to provide neatly trimmed, tidy and aesthetically pleasing perimeters, sympathetic to the site's design.
- Clippings shall be, as far as is consistent with machinery performance, an even spread of clippings which are well mulched.
- Paths and surrounds shall be free of clippings.
- There will be designated long grassed areas within each of the parks, exact locations to be confirmed

Start Date:

The successful applicant's contract will begin on: 1st January 2027 and will expire 31st December 2030.

Hours of work

The hours will be dictated by the contractor ensuring all list parks are cut

Payment

An invoice will be required to be sent to the Town Council each month confirming an equal set amount which must be clearly detailed in your submitted quotation.

The contractor will need to have the relevant insurance and will be required to submit to the Clerk work risk assessments and method statements

Should you be interested in quoting, please contact the Clerk for details of parks that will require cutting.
