The Town Council would also like to reiterate its previous comments in relation to the Neighbourhood Plan and asks that these continue to be given full consideration throughout the determination of the application.

We would be grateful if you could clarify the amendments and/or additions that have been made since the previous submission, particularly those arising from the consultation responses, so that the Town Council can fully understand the changes.

In addition, the Town Council requests confirmation that the 5-metre root protection zone around existing trees will be strictly enforced throughout the development. Furthermore, should any trees subsequently die or decline as a result of root damage associated with the development, the developer should be required to replace them on a like-for-like basis.
